In addition to their work in Bachelors Anonymous, founding members Robert Berg and David Hughes' collaborations have included the score for John Fleck's award-winning one man show, *I Got the He-Be-She-Be's*, UCLA Theater Arts production of Megan Terry's *Home*, and sound design for the film *Under the Gun*. Currently in the editing process is a music video of the Bachelors' song "Looking For You," with story by performance artist Tim Bennett, directed and edited by Adam Soch.
